XVII.Empowering Women: Rights Awareness Workshop by DIG Vipin Mishra with Green Group Women in Ayodhya









XXI.Warming Hearts: Blanket Distribution Drive by Hope Welfare Trust and Mukul Madhav Foundation




XXII.Warmth and Care: Blanket Distribution Campaign by Hope Welfare Trust
